Weather

The ASU Campus is equipped with a Lightning Prediction and Warning System called Weather Sentry (Telvent DTN). Should the Telvent DTN system send a text alert, the field will immediately be cleared and campers will be ushered to the Junell Center. In the event of RAIN, camp will go on as scheduled UNLESS the field is deemed unplayable and/or unsafe. At that point, we will go indoors and play futsal.




Maps & Directions

Texan Hall – On Google Maps, please type in ASU Texan Hall – or type in 2104 S Van Buren St.- San Angelo, TX 76909

This will guide your GPS directly to the Hall.

Without a GPS, you will head south on Van Buren St. until the end of the street. The Hall will be on your left hand side.

Q How do I sign up for the camp?

You can sign up online or print and mail in your registration. Please note that there is an online registration fee for credit card processing and convenience.

Q What does my child need to bring?

All campers should bring cleats, running/indoor soccer shoes, water bottle, shin guards, soccer ball, sun screen, and lunch and snacks.

Q Is there specific Goalkeeper training?

A Yes, goalkeepers will have specialized training as well as small sided and full field play.

Q Can parents stay and watch?

A Yes, parents are welcome to stay and watch the sessions.

Q Will there be a trainer and medical staff on site?

A No. We will not have a certified trainer on staff.

Q What is your refund policy?

A There is a non-refundable application fee of \$60. All refund requests must be made at least 1 week prior to the start of camp and must be submitted via email. No refunds will be issued within1 week prior to camp. Serious injury or sickness may be a consideration.

Q What is the refund policy as it pertains to weather cancellation?

Weather related cancellations are non-refundable. The ASU Soccer Camp will adhere to the proper lightning protocols. In the event of heavy rain, we will move on to the Intramural fields. In the event of persistent lightning we will move inside and continue with Indoor soccer (futsal).
