The Full Day Camp is a four-day camp for boys and girls ages 6-15 of all skill levels. The camp is designed to develop players technically and tactically. Campers will be able to practice proper technique when shooting, passing, receiving, dribbling, defending, etc.

There will also be games designed to develop the tactical knowledge and vision of players.

We will provide shade and regular water breaks. During our lunch break, we will head inside to the Junell Center to cool off and have lunch inside an ASU Classroom.

In the event of adverse weather, we will introduce them to Futsal, which is one of the best developers of technique in the world. The day will conclude with a dip in the ASU Ben Kelly Center for Human Performance swimming pool where we will have lifeguards on duty to monitor the campers. We will provide lifejackets for those that require them. Camper pick up will be at the pool.

Maps & Directions

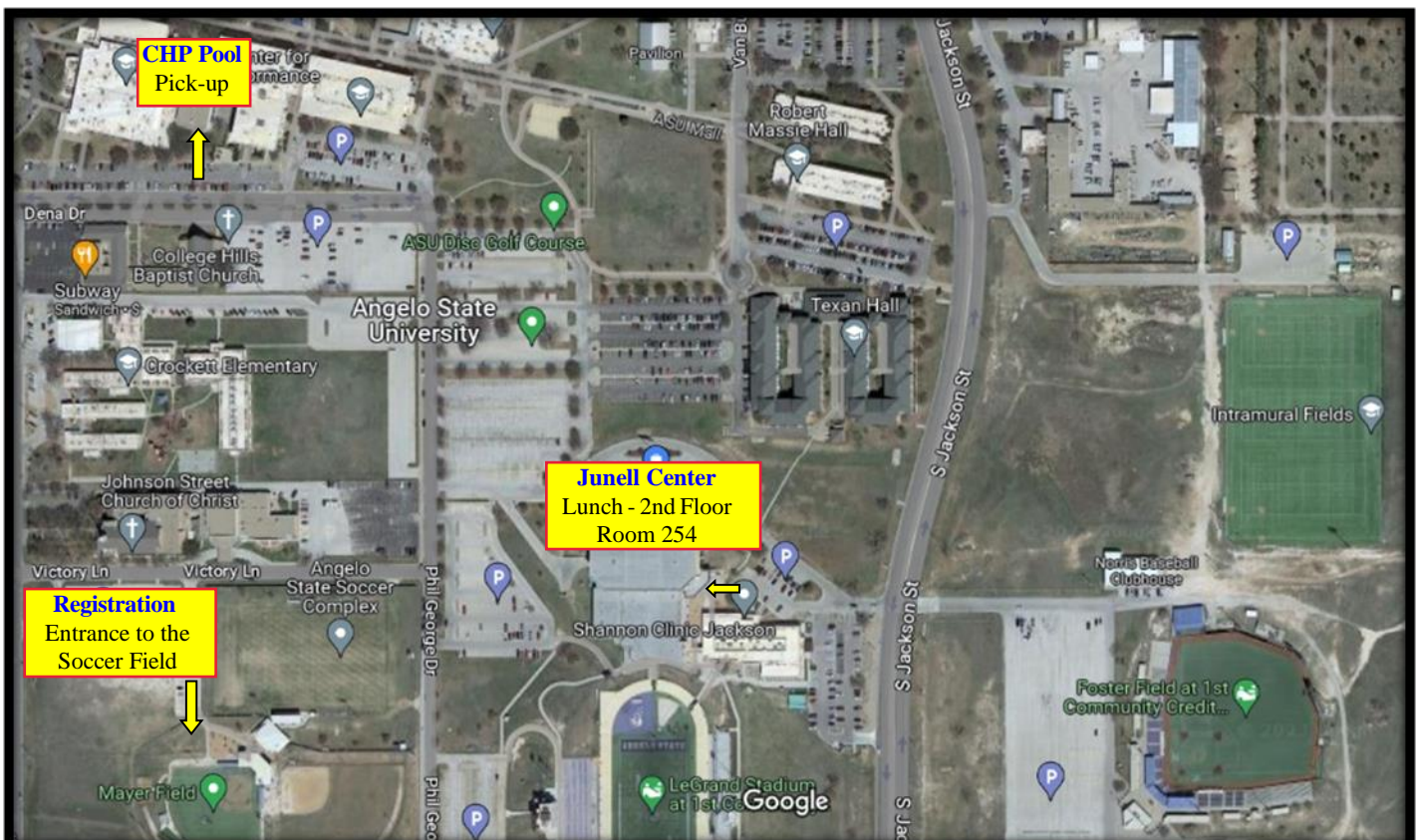

Frequently Asked Questions

Q How do I sign up for the camp?

A You can sign up online or print and mail in your registration. Please note that there is an online registration fee for credit card processing and convenience.

Q What does my child need to bring?

A All campers should bring cleats, running/indoor soccer shoes, water bottle, shin guards, soccer ball, sun screen, and lunch and snacks.

Q Is there specific Goalkeeper training?

A Yes, goalkeepers will have specialized training as well as small sided and full field play.

Q Can parents stay and watch?

A Yes, parents are welcome to stay and watch the sessions.

Q Will there be a trainer and medical staff on site?

A No. We will not have a certified trainer on staff.

Q What is your refund policy?

A There is a non-refundable application fee of \$50. All refund requests must be made at least 1 week prior to the start of camp and must be submitted via email. No refunds will be issued within 1 week prior to camp. Serious injury or sickness may be a consideration.

Q What is the refund policy as it pertains to weather cancellation?

A Weather related cancellations are non-refundable. The ASU Soccer Camp will adhere to the proper lightning protocols. In the event of heavy rain, we will move on to the Intramural fields. In the event of persistent lightning we will move inside and continue with Indoor soccer (futsal).
